April 1970, First National Lao Youth Conference, Vientiane. Boriboun Sitideth, Chair; Moua Chou, Vice-Chair.

April 1971, Ly Lue Touby Lyfoung, elected Youth President; Xiong Doua Lycee, Vice-President;

April 1972, Yang Nyia elected Youth President; Ly Her, Vice-President.

April 1973 and 1974, Lee Her, elected and re-elected Youth President;

Phou Vieng, Vice-President

April 1975, Unable to organize the Youth Conference due to the Communist took Control of Laos.
