

ASSISTANT PASTOR NextGen Ministry/English Service

Job Description (Full-time)

<u>PURPOSE</u>: The Assistant Pastor provides leadership, vision, and direction that creates a life-giving atmosphere of vibrant and enticing discipleship and evangelism for the *NextGen Ministry* (Young Adults Ministry and Couples Ministry—between the ages of 18 and 40) of the Hmong American Alliance Church (HAAC) of the Christian and Missionary Alliance (C&MA).

<u>SUMMARY OF DUTIES:</u> To oversee all programming and ministry for *NextGen Ministry* including Wednesday nights (mid-week prayer), Sunday School, *English Service* (in charge of HAAC's English Service), special events, etc.... as appropriate and approved by the Board of Elders and the Senior Pastor.

REQUIREMENTS: The successful candidate shall:

- 1. Be a born-again Christian.
- 2. Be an active member of HAAC.
- 3. Be ordained through the HD of the C&MA.
- 4. Have a heart for lost people.
- 5. Love Christ's church.
- 6. Have a bachelor's degree or equivalent.
- 7. Be fluent in English and Hmong.
- 8. Have exceptional leadership and communication skills.
- 9. Have a positive attitude and a positive approach to problem-solving. Must be solution oriented.
- 10. Have the ability to work effectively independently.
- 11. Have a heart for young adults and couples under 40.
- 12. Have leadership background and experience serving young adults and couples under 40.
- 13. Have strong organizational and leadership skills.
- 14. Have superior interpersonal skills working with a variety of people (all generations).
- 15. Have the ability to forecast and plan for continued growth.
- 16. Have the ability to build and lead volunteer teams.
- 17. Be pleasant, discreet, tactful, and capable of honoring confidential communications.
- 18. Have at least 2 years' experience serving as a pastor in a church.
- 19. Be a team player.

RESPONSIBILITIES: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform the following duties satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. There may be alternatives to the qualifications as the Board of Elders and Senior Pastor deem appropriate.

- 1. Assist the Senior Pastor in fulfilling God's ministry.
- 2. Oversee and organize the *NextGen Ministry* (Single Adult Ministry and Couple Ministry).
- 3. Oversee and lead the English Service.
- 4. Choose and prepare a curriculum for young adults and couples under 40.
- 5. Create environments, activities, and programming for *NextGen Ministry* that will facilitate learning and encourage spiritual growth.
- 6. Recruit, train, schedule, and lead teams of volunteers.
- 7. Provide care for the members within the church including hospital visits and follow-up.
- 8. Maintain a strategy for reaching and assimilating young adults and couples in the church.



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- 9. Communicate the gospel through various means to young adults and couples under 40.
- 10. Articulate and implement HAAC's vision.
- 11. Consistent communication with key leaders.
- 12. Work closely with Senior Pastor to analyze effectiveness of the ministry and adjust as needed.
- 13. Oversee and assist the various ministries and outreaches of HAAC as designated by the Senior Pastor and/or the Board of Elders.
- 14. Assist other ministries as needed.
- 15. Perform other duties as assigned.
- 16. Assist the Senior Pastor, the Nurturing Pastor, and the Board of Elders in shepherding the church through intentional love, prayers, and visitation.
- 17. Assist the Senior Pastor in shouldering and leading the church into a knowing, loving, and obedient relationship with Jesus Christ.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS: The benefits, holidays, vacation, and office hours shall be in accordance with the Employee Policy. This position reports to and is supervised by the Senior Pastor.

PHYSICAL AND/OR ENVIRONMENTAL DEMANDS: The physical and environmental demands described here are representative of those encountered and/or necessary for the employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- 1. Ability to work effectively in an environment with frequent interruptions and distractions.
- 2. Ambulatory skills: ability to transfer weight up to fifty pounds; ability to stand, walk, sit, stoop, kneel; possess hand-eye coordination and arm/hand/finger dexterity.
- 3. Ability to speak, hear, smell, and exercise visual acuity.
- 4. Driving/travel requirements for this position may require moderate to frequent driving; therefore, a valid driver's license is required.
