We are seeking a passionate **Children & Youth Ministry Director** or **Associate Pastor** to lead and nurture the next generation of believers, from nursery to youth.

Role Overview

This individual will oversee, develop, and integrate all children and youth ministry programs to foster spiritual growth and deepen each child's relationship with Jesus Christ. This role will maintain a vision for the ministries, organize events, lead volunteers, create a Christ-centered environment for our minors, and focus on the spiritual development of our children. The individual will work closely with the Lead Pastor, Leadership Team, and Ministry Leaders to develop a unified and impactful ministry.

Position Type

- U.S.-based
- Part-Time (average 15 hours per week)

Responsibilities

- Oversee ministries for Little Lights (0-K), City Kids (1st-5th), and City Youth (6th-12th)
- Develop a clearly defined vision, mission, and strategy for discipleship within the ministries, that works in conjunction with the overall vision and ministry of City on A Hill church
- Recruit, train (e.g: vision, safety, lesson planning), and motivate volunteers to serve in children's ministry
 - Ensure compliance with Safe Place Policy for child safety
- Plan and share a teaching schedule with volunteers
- Manage ministry budgets
- Select and develop age appropriate curriculums
 - o Provide resources or print outs for volunteers if needed for lessons
- Coordinate and oversee ministry events (e.g. parent date night, VBS, etc.)
- Teach on Sunday mornings as needed
- Establish regular communication with parents (Facebook) and volunteers (Discord)



- Create and maintain relationships with children, youth, and parents
- Maintain organized ministry records via Google Drives
- Attend and participate in church services, events, and activities
- Additional responsibilities may be assigned as needed (e.g. preaching/teaching, formal counseling, etc.)

Required Qualifications

Character: A disciple of Christ with a transformed heart and a calling to lead children to Christ.

Competency:

- Able to articulate the Gospel and the Word of God
- Passion for working with children & youth (0-18 years old)
- Experience in ministry leadership & administration
- Ability to unify and streamline ministries
- Communication and administrative skills

Education & Experience:

- Bachelor's degree in a related field with 1 year of experience in children's/youth ministry or 4 years of equivalent experience in lieu of a degree
- If applying as a Pastor, an accredited pastoral license is required
- Formal training in working with children
- Experience or willingness to serve in an Ethnic or Cross-Cultural church
- (Experience working with Special Needs children or special needs ministry is preferred but not required)

Alignment:

- Agreement with the City On A Hill Church's mission & vision
- Accepts the Christian & Missionary Alliance (C&MA) Statement of Faith, governance structure, and policies of C&MA church. Aligns with City On A Hill Church's core values.
