Job Title: Assistant Pastor Reports To: Senior Pastor Position Type: Full-Time

Location: Hmong American Alliance Church (HAAC), Maplewood, MN

<u>PURPOSE:</u> The Assistant Pastor provides compassionate, Christ-centered care to individuals and families within the congregation. This role is dedicated to shepherding the emotional, spiritual, and relational needs of the church body through personal connection, counseling, visitation, and support ministries. The Assistant Pastor helps create a culture of love, encouragement, and belonging, reflecting the heart of Christ in every interaction.

<u>SUMMARY OF DUTIES:</u> Provide personal pastoral care through hospital visits, home visits, crisis support, and follow-up. Offer emotional and spiritual support to the sick, elderly, bereaved, and hurting. Lead or coordinate ministries (Care Groups and Senior Ministry as needed) to help the growth of the church as appropriate and approved by the Board of Elders and the Senior Pastor.

REQUIREMENTS: The successful candidate shall:

- 1. Be a born-again Christian.
- 2. Be accredited or ordained through the HD of the C&MA.
- 3. Have a heart for lost people.
- 4. Love Christ's church.
- 5. Have exceptional leadership and communication skills.
- 6. Have the ability to work effectively independently.
- 7. Have strong organizational and leadership skills.
- 8. Have superior interpersonal skills working with a variety of people (all generations).
- 9. Have the ability to build and lead volunteer teams.
- 10. Be pleasant, discreet, tactful, and capable of honoring confidential communications.
- 11. Be a team player.

RESPONSIBILITIES: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform the following duties satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. There may be alternatives to the qualifications as the Board of Elders and Senior Pastor deem appropriate.

- 1. Oversee and assist the various ministries and outreaches of HAAC as designated by the Senior Pastor and/or the Board of Elders.
- 2. Assist the Senior Pastor in shouldering and leading the church into a knowing, loving, and obedient relationship with Jesus Christ.
- 3. Assist the Senior Pastor and the Board of Elders in shepherding the church through intentional love, prayer, and visitation.
- 4. Recruit, train, schedule, and lead teams of volunteers.
- 5. Maintain confidentiality and sensitivity in all matters.
- 6. Train and equip lay leaders or volunteers to assist in care ministries.
- 7. Promote a nurturing environment through church events, small groups, and fellowship.



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- 8. Encourage spiritual growth through mentoring, teaching, and relational discipleship.
- 9. Support small group ministry and connect individuals to appropriate discipleship pathways.
- 10. Work alongside ministry leaders to foster a welcoming and supportive church culture.
- 11. Articulate and implement HAAC's vision.
- 12. Consistent communication with key leaders.
- 13. Perform other duties as assigned by the Senior Pastor and/or the Board of Elders.
