- V. Special Privilege: Bruce Lyman, C&MA ESL**
- The Alliance ESL Director Bruce Lyman presented the ministry's vision of helping churches reach the nations that the Lord of the Harvest has brought into their communities. The Alliance ESL exists to cast vision, equip churches through workshops and coaching, and help them become both evangelistically focused and academically sound. The ministry was noted to be self-sustaining and cost-effective.

## **VII. Ministry Dialogue V: Hmong Study Bible, Finance, Secretary**

- Pastor Chao Xiong held a dialogue with Rev Tou Vue, Mai, and N Txoob.
  - A report was given on the progress of the Hmong Study Bible project, which began in 2021. It was reported that Genesis through Isaiah and the New Testament have been completed. The entire Hmong Study Bible is expected to be completed by the end of 2028 and distributed during the 2029 Annual Conference.
  - May Her highlighted the impact of the district's giving. She shared from 2 Corinthians 3:2–3 that transformed lives are the living testimony of the church's generosity, stating, "I am the result of your giving." She also reported that contributions increased from \$934,333.83 in 2015 to \$1,370,502.94 in 2025.
  - May Yang highlighted how churches are using the Annual Report to share stories of God's work—how He is converting lives and transforming hearts. She noted that these reports will serve as a valuable historical record for years to come, allowing future generations to see and celebrate what God has done among His people.


## **IX. Budget Committee**
