OVERVIEW:

The Alliance Church of Merced was established in 1982 to be the salt and light for the Hmong and surrounding communities of Merced, CA. As such, ACOM collaborates with many community partners and local churches. ACOM currently has numerous ministries which includes Sunday School, Wednesday Night Prayer, Alliance Men, Alliance Women, Children, Youth, Single Adults, Young Couples, Seniors, and Widows' ministries. Our membership consists of first-generation, 1.5 generation, and second-generation believers. Sunday Service and Wednesday Night Prayer are taught in both Hmong and English to meet the needs of our members. Our facility is also home to two other churches. We are seeking to build up the next generation of believers and leaders to share all of Jesus to all the world.

POSITION SUMMARY:

The Senior Pastor is responsible for the spiritual leadership and administrative oversight of the Alliance Church of Merced. He works collaboratively with the Governing Board, the Associate Pastor, and department leadership teams. The Senior Pastor is also responsible for preparing and delivering weekly sermons that are scripturally based. He must be enthusiastic about preaching, teaching, equipping the body of believers, and reaching the lost. Additionally, he must administer religious sacraments, provide pastoral care, and member visitations as needed. The Senior Pastor will provide biblical counseling to those that need it. He must possess excellent communication skills, have strong people skills, and be comfortable building relationships with children, youth, adults, and seniors from all walks of life.

In conjunction with the Governing Board, the Senior Pastor will help oversee the mission, vision, and strategy of the church. He will serve as the primary advocator, communicator, and leader of the church mission, vision, and strategy. He will lead the church to be mission-minded in fulfilling The Great Commission.

REPORTING RELATIONSHIPS:

The Senior Pastor reports to the Governing Board. He is also a member of the church and abides by the church bylaws.
