Ministry Project Updates 2022-2023

We also want to share the upcoming projects with you and your local AW and we ask for your partnership. The theme starting January 2023 is **Belong, “there is still room”** (Luke 14:22b).

Ministry Projects 2022-2023:

1. AWM/KHN partners with HCI (Hmong Christian Institute) to develop a Women's Leadership Certificate program (6 courses). Launch pilot program in 2023. Look out for more information.
2. Forty (40) Year Legacy Project - Goal is to raise \$40,000 to fund the Women's certificate program. Please send all donations by December 31, 2022. In January 2023 is the launch of this project, which means we are asking for help from all the local AW to fundraise or give generously from your heart towards this project.
